2018 Cabernet Sauvignon 1882

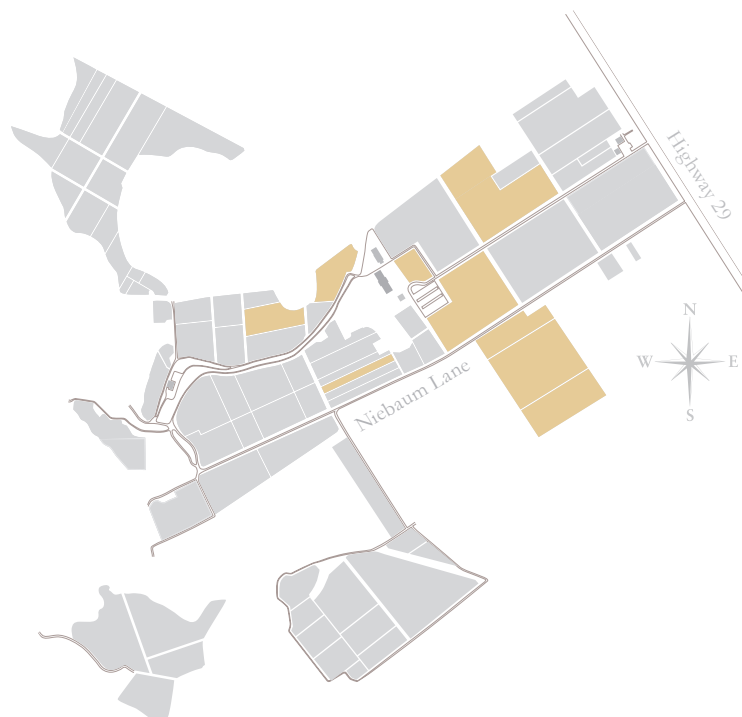
In 1882, Captain Gustave Niebaum produced his first vintage of Cabernet Sauvignon. Niebaum's status as one of the leading pioneers of Napa Valley's wine industry inspired us to produce our 1882 Cabernet Sauvignon on the same land.

Vintage Notes

The 2018 vintage delivered a generous crop of excellent quality. Well-timed precipitation in March and April encouraged slow, steady spring shoot development. Pleasantly warm temperatures throughout the season were ideal for gradual, even ripening of our Cabernet Sauvignon. Harvest of 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon 1882 began on September 19th and continued at a smooth pace, culminating on October 18th.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes

Tasting Notes Copy - With its deep, red garnet hue, 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon 1882 leads the nose to attractive notes of cocoa powder, black cherry, and ripe black plum. Immediately balanced and graceful on the palate, the wine shows ripe flavors of cassis and black cherry, with a deft touch of French oak on the finish. Full and well-textured, this vintage is particularly vibrant and fresh, with polished tannins of superb quality.
