## 2024 Sauvignon Blanc 1882

*In 1882, Captain Gustave Niebaum produced his first vintage of wine. Niebaum's status as one of the leading pioneers of Napa Valley's wine industry inspired us to produce our 1882 Sauvignon Blanc on the same land.*

### Vintage Notes

Bud break for the 2024 white and rosé vintage showed up right on time in early April, just after a stretch of cool, rainy days. By mid-May, the sun was shining and bloom rolled through the vineyards like clockwork. Spring and summer brought classically warm days balanced by cool nights. August arrived as the second coolest in a decade—perfect for locking in the crispness and clarity we love in our wines. Bathed in late August sunshine, our Niebaum-Pennino Sauvignon Blanc reached full ripeness with grace. Harvest began on August 15th, unfolding gently until Labor Day, when the final Semillon was gathered.

### Tasting Notes

The 2024 Sauvignon Blanc 1882 bursts with tropical aromas of pineapple and the vibrant blend of passion fruit, orange, and guava, creating an irresistible, fresh, and fruity profile. The palate is juicy and bright, with hints of yellow plum and the unique tang of starfruit adding layers of exotic fruit complexity. A subtle beachy breeze wafts through, giving the wine a fresh quality, while a touch of oyster shell minerality provides an intriguing, salty edge that elevates the experience. It's an invigorating, refreshing wine with plenty of tropical allure and a crisp, clean finish.
